SIEGFRIED AND ROY PARK

Fasten your seatbelts and put your seats and trays in their upright position. With the Russell Road realignment completed at the airport, the construction of Siegfried and Roy Park can take off! This 22 acre park located on the northwest corner of Maryland Parkway and the new Russell Road realignment was designed by Berry Ellison's team. It will be a green buffer between the new airport Terminal 3 and the existing houses. The park will include a water play area, a playground and restroom facilities. In the picture below you can see how the park design mimics that of the airport runways it neighbors. Lighting features casts light across the walking path similar to the light and shadow found on the runway.

We are very excited to watch as this park takes flight. We invite all to visit when it is completed.
